Effective Saturday, September 1, 2007, RT will implement a student fare increase. The increase is the final phase of a three-phase fare increase approved by the RT Board of Directors in June 2005.

The RT Student semi-monthly pass (sticker) will increase from \$17 to \$21.25 and the Student monthly pass (sticker) will increase from \$34 to \$42.50. The increase will bring the student rate in-line with all other RT discount fares (senior and disabled). All other student fares will remain the same.

Discount fares apply to students (age 5 to 18 pursuing a high school diploma), seniors (age 62 and older), individuals with disabilities, and Medicare cardholders; and require proper identification (photo ID) upon boarding.

RT Service to the State Fair

Planning a trip this year to the California State Fair? Avoid traffic congestion and over-crowded parking lots by riding the bus right to Cal Expo.

From August 17 through September 3, Routes 67 and 68 will drop off and pick up fairgoers at the Cal Expo main gate every 15 minutes. In addition, both routes stop at the 29th Street light rail station, allowing fairgoers to park for free at light rail park-and-ride stations and transfer to a bus at 29th Street.

Weekday buses run 15-minute intervals from 5:45 a.m. to 8:30 p.m. Weekend and Labor Day buses run 15-minute intervals from 10:08 a.m. to 7:51 p.m. Evening buses run at 30-minute intervals. The last bus leaves Cal Expo for the 29th Street light rail station at 11:13 p.m. every weeknight, on weekends and Labor Day.

On weekends and Labor Day, RT also operates special bus service from the Arden/Del Paso light rail station to the Cal Expo main gate every 15 minutes from 9:45 a.m. to 7:45 p.m. and every 30 minutes from 7:45 p.m. to 11:15 p.m.

RT is holding a public hearing to receive comments on proposed bus service changes affecting Routes 6, 9, 10, 13, 14, 18, 28, 34, 36, 50E, 61, 62, 63, 64, 65, 74, 75, 76, 83, 91, 105, 140 and 143 for implementation in January 2008.

These changes may include possible discontinuation or realignment of the above listed underperforming routes on various service days. Due to State budget cuts, RT is forced to consider reductions in service.

This is your opportunity to provide input before service reduction recommendations are adopted by the RT Board on August 27, 2007.

September 2007 Service Changes

ROUTE 22: ARDEN (WEEKDAY SCHEDULE CHANGES)

The 9:28 p.m. trip from Arden Fair Mall will be discontinued. Route 23 will continue to operate this trip. In addition, the 7:42 p.m. and 9:42 p.m. trips from the Arden/Del Paso light rail station will be discontinued. Route 23 will continue to operate these trips.

ROUTE 30: J ST. (DASH) & ROUTE 31: J ST. - RIVER PARK (WEEKDAY SCHEDULE CHANGES)

Certain Route 30 trips that depart downtown to CSUS have been converted to Route 31 trips. These changes have been implemented to provide more frequent service into River Park on Route 31. The frequency of service to CSUS will not be affected.

ROUTE 68: 44TH ST. (WEEKDAY SCHEDULE CHANGES)

The 7:44 a.m. trip from 44th Street and Fruitridge Road; the 3:03 p.m. trip from 34th Street and 2nd Avenue; and the 3:14 p.m. trip from Broadway and 34th Street will be discontinued.

ROUTE 72: ROSEMONT – LINCOLN VILLAGE (WEEKDAY SCHEDULE CHANGES)

The 7:58 a.m. trip from Lincoln Village Drive and Routier Road will depart 29 minutes earlier at 7:29 a.m. All times will shift accordingly.

ROUTE 143: OLD SACRAMENTO – CONVENTION CENTER (WEEKDAY SCHEDULE CHANGES)

Route 143 will change to operate “off-peak” hours running through April. The “off-peak” schedule will begin 30 minutes later at 11:04 a.m. and end two hours earlier at 5:27 p.m.

ROUTE 200: FLORIN RD. – FREEPORT BLVD. (WEEKDAY SCHEDULE CHANGES)

The 2:46 p.m. trip from Elmer Way and Casilada Way will depart two minutes earlier at 2:44 p.m. All times will shift accordingly.
