The Amador Regional Transit System's (ARTS) X Bus departs the University/65th Street light rail station Monday through Friday at 11:04 a.m. and arrives in Sutter Creek at 12:04 p.m. so visitors can enjoy an afternoon of shopping, dining and antiquing. The X Bus departs Sutter Creek at 3:39 p.m. and arrives back at the University/65th Street light rail station at 4:45 p.m.

The cost to ride the X Bus for passengers that show a valid RT monthly, daily or single-ride ticket upon boarding is \$1.75 each way or 75 cents for seniors (age 60 and over). RT Student photo ID cards permit students (age 5 to 18) who are pursuing a high school diploma to purchase discount RT Student stickers (fare). Monthly and Semi-monthly Student stickers can be purchased at retail outlets throughout the Sacramento region and at over 20 local schools.



Ride RT to the California State Fair



Fairgoers will have 18 days in 2008 to enjoy some "Big Fun" at the California State Fair. The State Fair will run from August 15 to Sepember 1, including Mondays and Labor Day.

RT bus routes 67 and 68 will drop off and pick up fairgoers at the Cal Expo main gate. Weekday, weekend and Labor Day buses operate on 15-minute intervals. Evening buses operate on 30-minute intervals (after 8 p.m.). The last bus leaves Cal Expo for the 29th Street light rail station at 11:13 p.m. every evenina.

On weekends and Labor Day, RT also operates bus service from the Arden/Del Paso light rail station to the Cal Expo main gate every 15 minutes from 9:45 a.m. to 7:45 p.m. and every 30 minutes from 7:45 p.m. to 11:15 p.m. The last bus leaves Cal Expo for the Arden/Del Paso light rail station at 11:26 p.m. every evening.

Rider Alert

September 2008 Service Changes

Effective Sunday, August 31, 2008, RT will implement service changes. These route and schedule changes include the modification of the following routes:

Route 4: Meadowview - Gerber (Weekday Schedule Changes):

All trips on Route 4 will arrive and depart the Meadowview light rail station one minute earlier. This change will improve bus and light rail connections.

Route 5: Meadowview – Vallev Hi (Route and Schedule Changes):

Eight trips on Route 5 will be realigned (four in each direction) to serve the Verandas Senior Apartments on Power Inn Road. During these eight trips only, service to Florin High School will be discontinued. In addition, all trips on Route 5 will arrive and depart the Meadowview light rail station one minute earlier. This change will improve bus and light rail connections.

Route 72: Rosemont – Lincoln Village (Weekday Schedule Changes):

The 3:14 p.m. trip departing Branch Center Road and Kiefer Boulevard will be adjusted to depart five minutes earlier at 3:09 p.m.

Route 255: La Riviera - College Greens (Weekday Schedule Changes):

The two 3:14 p.m. trips departing Kiefer Boulevard and Mayhew Road will be adjusted to depart five minutes earlier at 3:09 p.m.



Pre-Paid Pass and Ticket Exchange (August 1 - September 30)

Effective Monday, September 1, 2008, RT buses and light rail fare vending machines will not accept pre-paid passes and tickets with an August 31, 2008 expiration date. During a twomonth period beginning August 1, passengers may exchange Basic and Discount daily passes or single-ride tickets with this expiration date for new fare media of the same value.

RT will conduct even exchanges of fare media (August 31, 2008 expiration date only) from August 1 through September 30 at:

Expiration dates on pre-paid passes and tickets allow RT to plan for future fare changes and remove outdated fare media from circulation. The new fare media will be valid until June 30, 2010, unless a fare change occurs prior to this date.
