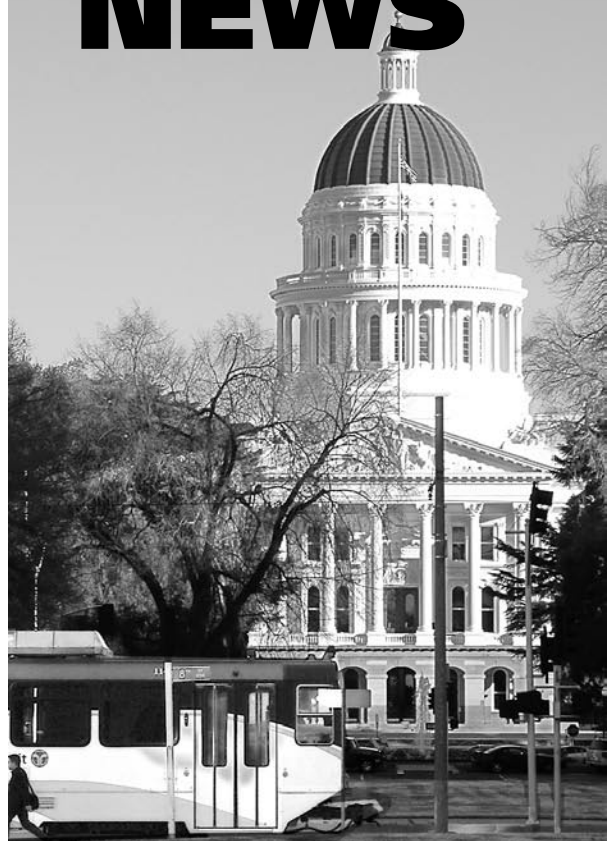

Ride RT on Museum Day

Twenty-five greater Sacramento area museums will be offering free admission during the 10th Annual Sacramento Museum Day. Sacramento Museum Day takes place on Saturday, February 2 from 10 a.m. to 4 p.m. (all participating museums close at 5 p.m.).

Avoid traffic and parking fees by taking RT to the Archives Plaza light rail station and then transferring to free Museum Day shuttle buses provided by the Sacramento Association of Museums.

The California Museum for History, Women & the Arts, located near the Archives Plaza light rail station, is the central hub for the Sacramento Museum Day shuttle. The free shuttle buses will serve many of the participating museums.

In addition, you can park your car and ride light rail to the Sacramento Valley Station, which is just a two-block walk from Old Sacramento and its many museums.
