

# January 2008 Service Changes

## **Route 2: Riverside** (Weekday Schedule Changes):

The 5:31 a.m. trip departing Rush River Drive and Windbridge Drive will depart two minutes earlier at 5:29 a.m. All times will shift accordingly. Schedule adjustment will improve connection with light rail at the 8th & O Station.

## **Route 6: Land Park** (Sunday and Holiday Service Changes):

Sunday and holiday service will be discontinued.

## **Route 8: Power Inn – Florin Mall** (Weekend and Holiday Schedule Changes):

Schedule adjustments will be made to improve connections to and from the Power Inn Station.

## **Route 9: Carmichael – Walnut Avenue** (Saturday Service Changes):

Saturday service will be discontinued.

## **Route 10: Carmichael – Dewey Drive** (Saturday Service Changes):

Saturday service will be discontinued.

## **Route 18: Del Paso Heights – Bell Avenue** (Saturday Service Changes):

Saturday service will be discontinued.

## **Route 21: Sunrise – Citrus Heights** (All Service Days):

Route 21 will be extended to serve the Louis and Orlando transit center in Roseville that was formerly served by Route 91.

## **Route 28: Fair Oaks – Folsom** (Sunday and Holiday Service Changes):

Sunday and holiday service will be discontinued.

## **Route 36: Folsom** (Weekend and Holiday Service Changes):

Weekend and holiday service will be discontinued.

## **Route 47: Phoenix Park** (Saturday Schedule Changes):

The 8:29 a.m. trip departing 25th Street and Florin Road will be discontinued.

## **Route 50E: Stockton Boulevard** (Weekday Schedule Changes):

The frequency on Route 50E will be adjusted to operate every 30 minutes all day.

## **Route 55: Scottsdale** (Weekday Schedule Changes):

The 5:37 p.m. trip departing Cosumnes River College will be adjusted to depart at 5:45 p.m. All times will shift accordingly.

## **Route 61: Fruitridge** (Sunday and Holiday Service Changes):

Sunday and holiday service will be discontinued.

## **Route 62: Freeport** (Weekends and Holiday Schedule Changes):

Service on Route 62 will be adjusted to operate every 60 minutes on Saturdays only. Sunday and holiday service will be discontinued.

## **Route 63: 24th St. – City College – Hogan** (Weekday Service Changes):

Route 63 will be realigned to operate between the Meadowview and 16th Street light rail stations. Service north of the 16th Street Station will be discontinued. Route 63 will also be extended to serve Sacramento City College.

## **Route 64: 24th St. – City College**

Route 64 will be discontinued. Route 63 will now serve Sacramento City College.

## **Route 76: La Riviera – American River**

Route 76 will be discontinued.

## **Route 83: 14th Avenue** (Weekday Service Changes):

Route 83 will be realigned to operate between Sacramento City College and the Power Inn light rail station. Service west of Sacramento City College and service between the Power Inn and University/65th Street light rail stations will be discontinued.

## **Route 87: Howe** (Weekday Schedule Changes):

Certain afternoon trips will shift to improve connections at both the Marconi/Arcade and University/65th Street light rail stations. The 5:46 p.m. trip departing the Marconi/Arcade Station will be discontinued.

## **Route 91: Citrus Heights – Sunrise**

Route 91 will be discontinued. Route 21 will now serve the Louis and Orlando transfer center.

## **Route 105: Madison**

Route 105 will be discontinued.

## **Route 140: Ziggurat – Downtown** (Weekday Schedule Changes):

Service will be reduced to operate during peak hours only (6 a.m. to 9 a.m. and 3 p.m. to 6 p.m.). Service will operate every 15 minutes.

## **Route 143: Old Sac – Convention Center** (Weekday Service Changes):

Route 143 weekday service will be discontinued. Saturday service will continue to operate.

## RT Launches New Video Control Center

RT's new Video Control Center (VCC) features an array of monitors allowing video surveillance of RT's light rail system.

With the cameras, RT's police and security force can view real-time images at all 47 light rail stations throughout Sacramento, Rancho Cordova and Folsom. RT police officers and security guards can monitor, report and quickly dispatch security forces when necessary.

Funding for the VCC was provided by a 2005 Transit Security Grant from the Department of Homeland Security.
