RT will operate continuous bus service on a dedicated route from the Mather Field/Mills light rail station located until 5

RT Rider Alert:

Bus routes 21, 28, 72, 73 and 74 will NOT operate in the Mather Field/Mills bus loop on Saturday, June 9 or Sunday, June 10. All routes will be relocated to the bus stop on Folsom Boulevard north of the light rail station.

Route 75 will not operate during the weekend due to Airshow traffic.

The Mather Field/Mills parking lot will be closed on Saturday, June 9 and Sunday, June 10, due to Airshow traffic. Any cars parked in the lot on this weekend will be towed at the owner's expense.
