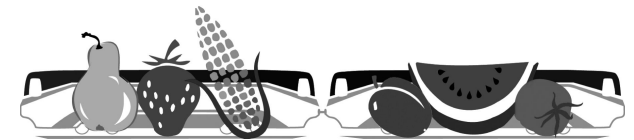


## Family Safety and Health Expo

## Back to School with RT

Beat the rush and get your RT Student photo ID card before the school year begins!

RT Student photo ID cards can be obtained at the RT Customer Service and Sales Center for only \$2 during the months of June, July and August (\$3 after Wednesday, August 31). Students (age 5 to 18) must show proof of current school enrollment, or be accompanied by a parent or guardian to receive an RT Student photo ID card.

By purchasing your Student photo ID card in advance, you can ride RT at the student rate all summer long. Monthly and Semi-Monthly student stickers (fare) can be purchased at retail outlets throughout the Sacramento region (stickers must be affixed to a valid RT Student photo ID card). 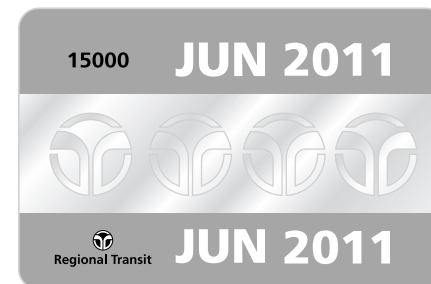
## Ride RT to Rancho Cordova's 4th of July Celebration

Orders usually ship first-class mail within one to two business days and may take up to five days to be delivered. A shipping and handling charge will apply to online purchases.
