
Take RT to the event! Ride light rail to the Mather Field/Mills light rail station and then board Route 21 to Hagan Park.

June 2012 Service Changes

Effective Sunday, June 17, 2012, RT will implement the following service changes:

Route 38: P/Q Streets (Weekday Schedule Changes)

Trips departing 5th Street and Broadway at 6:32 a.m. and 7:28 a.m. will be adjusted to depart at 6:23 a.m. and 7:23 a.m. All other times will shift accordingly. Arrival times at the University/65th Street Transit Center will remain the same.

Route 103: Auburn Blvd. (Weekday Schedule Changes)

Trips departing the Watt/I-80 light rail station at 4:26 p.m., 4:56 p.m. and 5:26 p.m. will be adjusted to depart 10 minutes later at 4:36 p.m., 5:06 p.m. and 5:36 p.m. to improve bus and light rail connections. All other times will shift accordingly. The 5:56 p.m. trip will be adjusted in September 2012.

Green Line to the River District Safety Tips

RT has activated high voltage wires above the light rail tracks on the future Green Line to the River District light rail extension. These wires are extremely dangerous! Stay clear of this high voltage area and the overhead wires.

Last month, RT began operating Green Line light rail test trains between the 13th Street and the 7th & Richards/Township 9 light rail stations. Testing may take place anytime during the day or night. The public is reminded to adhere to the following safety rules:

- Always be alert in light rail stations and look both ways before crossing the light rail tracks.
- · Do not walk along or next to light rail tracks. Light rail trains are relatively quiet and may approach from any direction at any time. Trespassers will be cited.
- Pedestrians need to use the sidewalk located on the west side of 7th Street between F and North B streets when walking under the overpass.
- Always stand behind the yellow detectible warning tiles while waiting for a light rail train at a station.
- Headphones and electronic devices are distractions and can divert your attention from oncoming light rail trains.

- It is prohibited to ride bicycles, skateboards or rollerblades in light rail stations.
- It is prohibited to jump the coupler between light rail cars. Violators will be prosecuted.
- Crossing gates in a down position signal that a light rail train is nearby.
 It is prohibited for pedestrians, bicyclists and motorists to cross the tracks when the crossing gates are in the down position.
- It is illegal and dangerous to park vehicles on light rail tracks.

Track Your Bus In Real-Time Using RT Tracker!

Recently installed GPS technology allows customers to track RT buses on routes, view their locations using online maps and receive estimated arrival times for any bus stop.

The real-time system, called RT Tracker, can be found at www.sacrt.com/rttracker. No registration is required to view the location of your bus or look up its estimated arrival time at your stop.

Customers can also sign up to receive automatic email or text message alerts containing estimated arrival times.

To look up estimated arrival times at a bus stop using text messaging, send the keyword SACRT, followed by a space, and your Stop ID number to 41411. The Stop ID can be found on the back of every RT bus stop sign.

Real-time tracking of light rail vehicles is not currently offered, but is included in plans for RT Tracker expansion when funding becomes available.

Students (age 5 to 18) must show proof of current school enrollment, or be accompanied by a parent or guardian to receive an RT Student photo ID card.
