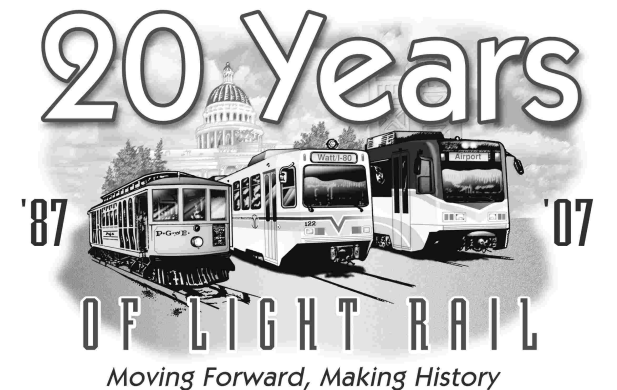

You can even send that important e-mail on one of the café's computers where internet access is offered for a fee, or hook your laptop into the mobile wireless service.

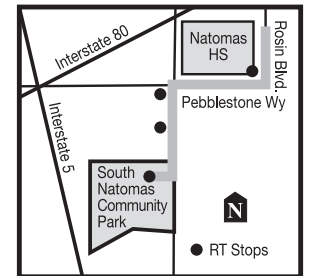
The café opens mid-September and will offer free internet access for the first month.
