September Service Changes

Effective Sunday, September 4, 2011, RT will implement service changes to Route 1.

Route 1: Greenback (Weekday Service Changes)

Route 1 will be extended to serve James Way and Arnold Avenue in the McClellan Business Park. Trips arriving and departing Luce Avenue and Peacekeeper Way will be adjusted. All other operating times will remain the same.

Extended Light Rail Service for Folsom LIVE!



Historic Sutter Street will rock for two days when Folsom LIVE!

returns for 2011 on Friday, September 23 and Saturday, September 24. This year's venue will feature 30 bands on 10 indoor and outdoor stages, including Pat Benatar and Neil Giraldo; Los Lobos; Ronnie Milsap; and Tainted Love. The festivities will kick off at 5 p.m. on both days.

Folsom LIVE! attendees can ride RT light rail trains free to and from the event with a valid pre-purchased admission ticket. In addition, RT will operate extended evening light rail service to the Historic Folsom Station every 30 minutes until 11 p.m. on Friday, September 23 and Saturday, September 24.

One-day Folsom LIVE! tickets are \$37.50 in advance or \$45 at the gate; two-day tickets are \$65 in advance or \$70 at the gate. A one-day party pack for four is \$120 or \$199 for two days.
