September 2012 Service Improvements

Effective Sunday, September 2, 2012, RT will implement major service improvements that will extend night service on light rail and nine major bus routes, increase frequency on highly-utilized bus routes, and restructure bus routes to better serve riders.

Route 75 Will Not Operate During the Airshow

Due to traffic and road closures during the California Capital Airshow at Mather Airport, RT will not operate Route 75 on Saturday, September 8 and Sunday, September 9.

Extended Light Rail Service for Folsom LIVE!



Historic Sutter Street will rock when Folsom LIVE! returns on Saturday, September 22. This year's venue will feature 15 bands on five indoor and outdoor stages, including Jack Ingram, Wonderbread 5, Journey Unauthorized, East Bay Soul and Arden Park Roots. The festivities will kick off at 5 p.m.

RT will extend Gold Line light rail service to Folsom until 11 p.m. for one night only. Folsom LIVE! attendees can ride light rail free with a valid pre-purchased admission ticket.

Light rail service on the Gold Line will continue to Folsom beyond the last regularly scheduled departure from the Sunrise Station at 7:09 p.m. Light rail service to Folsom will continue from the Sunrise Station at 7:39 p.m., 8:09 p.m., 8:39 p.m., 9:09 p.m., 9:39 p.m., 10:09 p.m. and 10:39 p.m. Trains will arrive at the Historic Folsom Station 13 minutes after departure from the Sunrise Station.

Light rail service on the Gold Line will continue from Folsom beyond the last regularly scheduled departure from the Historic Folsom Station at 7 p.m. Light rail service to Sunrise/Downtown Sacramento will depart from the Historic Folsom Station at 7:30 p.m., 8 p.m., 8:30 p.m., 9 p.m., 9:30 p.m., 10 p.m., 10:30 p.m. and 11 p.m.

Trips departing the Historic Folsom Station at 9:30 p.m. or earlier will end at the Sacramento Valley Station. Trips departing the Historic Folsom Station at 10 p.m. and later will end at the St. Rose of Lima Park (9th & K) Station. The last train departing from the Historic Folsom Station at 11 p.m. will arrive at the St. Rose of Lima Park (9th & K) Station at 11:55 p.m.
