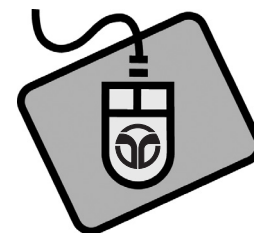
Help RT Prioritize Transit Needs – Take the Survey

RT is currently developing “TransitRenewal,” a comprehensive in-depth analysis of the entire RT bus and light rail system that will result in recommendations for transit service improvements that will be implemented over the next five years.

The need for the analysis was identified after economic conditions required RT to implement major service reductions in June 2010. The outcome of TransitRenewal will provide recommendations that will determine how to restore, restructure and “renew” transit service by developing the most efficient and effective transit network possible, within available funding.

The study includes a comprehensive public outreach process that includes community meetings and a number of other ways for RT customers and stakeholders to provide their input.
